**'Gallo Dark Bicolour'** USPP#20718: Big bicolor blooms! Petals are bright red in center, bright yellow on the outer half. Spiky rounded centers are also red and yellow. Flowering height: 9" to 10" in containers.

**NEW! 'Gallo Fire'** USPPAF: Big cheerful orange flowers subtly tipped in yellow. An improvement on 'Gallo Orange'. Flowering height: 9" in containers.

**'Gallo Orange'** USPPAF: Rich orange-red petals are subtly tipped in gold. Centers are reversed, with deep red surrounding yellow hearts. Flowering height: 9" in containers.

**'Gallo Peach'** USPP#20717: Bicolor flowers, bright yellow with gold accents. Spiky centers are yellow-orange with red tips. Flowering height: 7" in containers.

**'Gallo Red'** USPPAF: Solid red flowers with darker, burnt-umber centers. Flowering height: 10" in containers.

**'Gallo Yellow'** USPP#20716: Two-pointed petals of sweet, pure yellow with the faintest suspicion of a gold tinge. Centers are also solid yellow, darkening to ruddy gold after the petals drop for an extra color accent. Flowering height: 8" in containers.

**NEW! 'Gallo Yellow Trumpet'** USPPAF: Trumpet flower form with red flutes and yellow tips. Center is red with yellow eye. Flowering height: 9" in containers.

The *Gaillardia* Gallo series makes the perfect "in-between" crop to squeeze in an extra turn year after year! Plant liners April 1 and ship by mid-June, before your outdoor space is needed for garden mum production.

## Flowering Pot Crop Production Schedule

Plant one 72-liner per pot. We recommend finishing in a quart or 1-gallon container.

**Pinching:** Not required for 72s, as they are pinched shortly after propagation to encourage branching, full habit, and uniform finishing.

**Vernalization:** Not required.

**Fertilizer:** 150 ppm nitrogen constant liquid feed

**Temperature:** Minimum night 55°F/13°C, day 65°-75°F/18°-24°C.

**Flowers** in 8-9 weeks after transplant from unvernallized 72-liner.

**Height at flowering:** 7" to 10" in containers depending on variety.
